

Parent's Code of Conduct

The goal of this Code of Conduct is to make the South County Football League a healthy and worthwhile activity for children and their families.

I hereby support the SCFL programs by following the Parent Code of Conduct that follows:

1. I will demonstrate a supportive and positive attitude for all players, coaches, opponents, administrator, and officials. If a disagreement occurs, I will settle it without resorting to hostility.
2. I understand my responsibilities in helping my child enjoy the SCFL experience, which includes teaching my child fair play, and to play according to the rules, assisting the coaches and /or the team mom, and volunteering for SCFL activities as I can.
3. I will always keep in mind that the game is for the children – not adults. I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the SCFL.
4. I will accept the results of each game, focusing on the children's efforts and performance and teach my child to be gracious in victory. I will help my child turn defeat into victory by encouraging learning ways to improve.
5. My child and I will respect the rights and dignity of all participants, players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
6. I understand that behavior that degrades a player, coach, referee, or other parents, is subject to disciplinary action by the SCFL Board of Directors.
7. I will aid in providing a safe and healthy environment by abiding by the posted park rules.
8. I will read the SCFL Rules and follow the guidelines established by the SCFL Board of Directors.
9. I am responsible for insuring that my child attends practices and games' realizing that full participation enables my child to – participate as an important member of a team.
10. I understand that my attitude shown towards my child, other team members, the opposing team, officials, and the coaches influences my child's values and behavior in sports. Criticism and disrespect undermines the purpose of youth sports.
